



Return to Learn Steering Committee Preliminary Recommendations

- Daily symptomatic screening in place for faculty and staff.
- Daily symptomatic screening in place in August for students.
- Testing capacity through the UC San Diego Center for Advanced Laboratory Medicine (CALM) Lab ramping up to 6,000 daily by the fall.
- Testing capacity through the research lab of Rob Knight, founding director of the Center for Microbiome Innovation and professor of Pediatrics and Computer Science & Engineering at UC San Diego, is also ramping up to 6,000 daily by the fall.
 - CALM will focus on clinical testing (patients, Health system and community), and the Knight Lab on surveillance (campus community, affiliates and partners).
- Priority testing will be for symptomatic employees and students or those with possible exposure.
- Additional capacity will allow for periodic asymptomatic testing of the entire student, faculty and staff population.
- Testing is free for faculty and staff contacted by the UC San Diego Center for Occupational and Environmental Medicine (COEM) and tested through the Health System, and for students through Student Health Services.
